

QUILT & BLUEGRASS FESTIVAL – Quilt Registration
Saturday November 19, 2016 10 AM – 5 PM
Thornebrook Village - 2441 NW 43rd Street – Gainesville, FL

This exhibit of 75+ quilts from Gainesville, Alachua County and the surrounding counties is a non-juried exhibition of traditional and modern quilts made by quilters of all levels – beginner to advanced alike. We encourage young quilters to submit entries! Since this is not a juried show, no prizes will be awarded.

QUILT REGISTRATION, TO INCLUDE AN EXECUTED HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT, IS REQUIRED. QUILTS MUST BE CLEAN, AND DEVOID OF SMELLS AND ANIMAL HAIR. We will have limited display for small quilts and home décor items. All quilts must have a sewn on tag on the back of your quilt with the quilters' name and the name of the quilt.

QUILT DISPLAY: Quilts will be hung underneath the walkway overhangs by clothespins on clothesline, similar to the Trenton exhibits. Everything possible will be done to protect your quilts from the elements and direct contact by the viewing public; white-gloved helpers will be available in all display areas to assist viewers wishing a closer look at a quilt, along with signs asking the public not to touch the quilts.

QUILT STATEMENT: Please print a short statement about how your quilt came to be on a full sheet of paper and attach it to your quilt registration form. What was your inspiration for making the quilt? Was this quilt made for a special person or occasion? What patterns did you use to make this quilt? Were you inspired by a certain designer or line of fabrics? Did you use a special technique? Is this an original design? If you began this quilt in a class, what was the name of the class and its instructor? If the quilt has been quilted by someone else, please list both your name and the quilter's on the registration form. ***In order to honor copyrights to designs please include any of the following where applicable: the name of the pattern and its designer; the name of the pattern and the magazine it was published in; and/or the name of the pattern and the title and author of any book.***

YOU CAN SELL YOUR QUILT by indicating so on the registration form. Your asking price will be included on the sign attached to your quilt. The buyer will make their check out to your name and pick up the quilt after the show upon payment. Both the buyer and quiltmaker will be given a receipt.

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT ENTRY FORMS FOR THE SHOW IS November 10, 2016.

Registration forms are on the websites of Thornebrook Village (www.thornebrookvillage.com), A1 Sewing (www.a1sewing.com), and the Quilters of Alachua County Day Guild (www.qacd.org). Forms can also be picked up at A1 Sewing or the Suwannee Valley Quilt Shoppe (517 North Main Street, Trenton, FL 32693, 352-463-3842). ***Keep a copy of your receipt to present at quilt pick-up.***

QUILTS MUST BE DELIVERED TO A1 SEWING (2441 NW 43rd Street, Suite 22, Gainesville, FL 32606, 352-371-9464) from 9AM to 5PM daily between Monday, November 14 and Thursday, November 17, the last day to drop off quilts. **Quilt pick-up from A1 Sewing** is: Monday, November 21, 9AM-5PM, Tuesday November 22, 9AM-5PM and Wednesday November 23 9AM-Noon. (A1 closes early on Wednesday so that staff may be with their families for the Thanksgiving holidays.)
