

CLASS TITLE: DISAPPEARING 9-PATCH WITH A TWIST THU 16 FEB AM
SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER
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CLASS DESCRIPTION: This pattern was introduced by Claire Batchelder a few years ago. It is a “stash busting” fun pattern. The quilt size depends on the size of your 9-patch squares (see below)



SUPPLIES:

The Usual Items:

- Sewing machine – cleaned and ready to go
- Bobbins – several – all filled (neutral color is best)
- Power cords
- Scissors or snips
- Rotary cutter with sharp blade
- Rotary mat and rule (a long one if you are doing the larger 9-inch patches)

Bring to class finished at least (2) 9-patch blocks of your choice of size

- 5-inch squares will yield 8 squares @4-1/2 inches each. 14 nine patches will make a throw size
- 6-1/2 inch squares will yield 8 squares @ 6 inches each. 6 nine patches will make a throw size
- 9-inch squares will yield 8 squares @8-1/2 inch each. 5 nine patches make a throw size.
- 10-inch squares will yield 8 squares @ 9-1/2 inch each. 4 nine patches make a large throw size.

NOTE: These are approximate depending on your 1/4 seam allowance, so there will be a couple patches left for throw pillows!
