



**CLASS TITLE:** FABRIC PORTFOLIO **WED FEB 15 PM**

**CLASS DESCRIPTION:** **THERE IS REQUIRED PRE-CLASS PREP (see next page)**



### **FABRIC SUPPLIES:**

For your center piece

(10) 5" charm squares

**OR** use some of your 2½" strips – cut (20) 2½" x 4½"

**OR** (10) 4½" squares that measure 4 1/2 inch square)

1/4 yard for main fabric (this will be your top and bottom strips)

3/4 yard for your accent fabric for end flaps and your lining

2 1/2 yards of heavy-weight fusible interfacing (I prefer Pellon 808, but if you find it in a wide (42") width, you only need 1 1/4 yards. This interfacing is moderately heavy – there's a heavier one, but that's more difficult to work with – but the 808 has enough body without being stiff as a board

(1) 12" zipper (polyester is best, otherwise you could break needles trying to sew it over the ends! You know how I know this!

(1) strip set 1½" long velcro

**OPTIONAL:** 3/4 yard trim (such as jumbo rick rack, covered piping etc. – visual only and not necessary for construction

(1) 1-7/8" covered button (again, visual, can be omitted.)

### **OTHER SUPPLIES:**

Machine in good working order, cleaned and ready to go

Machine foot pedal and power cord

Filled bobbins (at least 2, but 3 won't hurt) and spool(s) of project thread

Cutting board, ruler and cutter with a sharp blade

Extension cord or power strip

Scissors

Pins

Whatever you usually have to make your day enjoyable!!

## **ADVANCE PREPARATION CUTTING DIRECTIONS:**

**Press all fabrics before cutting, makes it so much easier.**

**Pieces MUST be cut before class, otherwise we will have no time to construct this project**

FROM 5" CHARM SQUARES or 2½" strips CUT:

(20) 2 1/2 "x 4 1/2" rectangles

FROM MAIN FABRIC CUT:

(2) 2 3/4" x 20 1/2" strips

FROM ACCENT FABRIC CUT:

(2) 5"x13" (closure flap)

(2) 10-1/2" x 13" (lining)

(1) 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" (small pocket)

(1) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" (pencil tab)

FROM POCKET FABRIC CUT:

(2) 10-1/2" x 7-1/2" (zipper pocket)

(2) 10-1/2" x 8-1/2" (zipper pocket)

(1) 10-1/2" x 23-1/2"(paper pocket)

FROM INTERFACING CUT:

(1) 5"x 13" (closure flap)

(2) 10-1/2" X 13" (lining)

(1) 10-1/2" x 7-1/2" (zipper pocket)

(1) 10-1/2" x 8-1/2" (zipper pocket)

(1) 10-1/2" x 23-1/2" (front unit)

(1) 13x25 inch piece (front cover)

It will help if you attach - with pins or sticky notes - little notes as to size and function for the different pieces. Yes, I know there seems to be duplicate listings (like zipper pocket pieces) but believe me, they are correct and needed!!!
