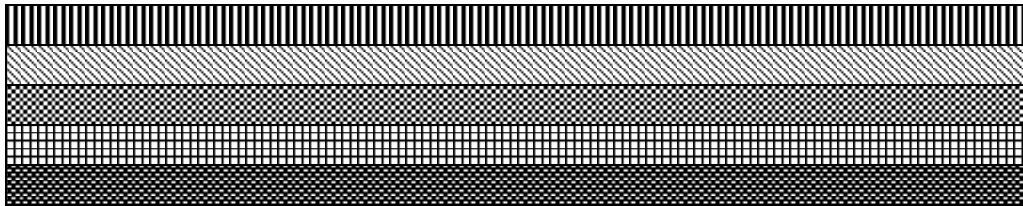
CLASS DESCRIPTION: An absolutely no-waste jelly roll quilt that is a cinch to make and has lots of visual interest. Great for a quick project or last-minute gift.

SUPPLIES FOR CLASS:

- 1 jelly roll
- Rotary cutting ruler
- Rotary cutting mat
- **Rotary cutter with a fresh blade**
- 3 bobbins
- Thread to blend well with your fabrics
- Pins (please weed out bent or dull pins!)
- 2 or 3 replacement machine needles

PRE-CLASS PREP WORK:

- select 10 strips you'd like to use for the center accent pieces, and divide them into two sets of 5 strips; roll up each accent strip set and put into a separate ziplock bag; put the remaining strips into a large ziplock bag
- optional: sew the strips of each accent set together along the long edge – alternating the sewing direction for each strip to avoid curving – to create two strip sets that look like the illustration below. Press seam allowances to one side (it doesn't matter which).



SUPPLIES FOR FINISHING (not needed for class):

- Binding: ½ yard, cut into (6) strips 2½" x WOF
- Backing & Batting: 56" x 66"
