

CLASS TITLE: FLOWER POWER QUILT 36"x42" **THU FEB 16 ALL DAY**
FEE \$6, paid day of class
SKILL LEVEL: CONFIDENT BEGINNER
TEACHER: LYN WHITE

CLASS DESCRIPTION: A variation of "Just Bloom" from McCall's Quick Quilts Dec/Jan 2015.

Pattern provided after registration form and payment are submitted.



ADVANCE PREPARATION: Using the petal pattern provided with the quilt pattern, cut the designated number of petals before coming to class. Bring extra uncut fabric to class so that you have several options for arranging your petals.

SUPPLIES:

1 yard of fabric for the front of the quilt

1 yard of back fabric

16 – 18 fat 8ths or fat quarters – for flower petals and center of flower

NOTE: Batiks **DO NOT WORK WELL** because they are woven very tightly and do not shred much – make sure you pick colors that contrast well with your background

3 sizes of batting

- 1 – size of your front and back
- 1 – size of your flower
- 1 – size of your flower center

1/8 yard of black tulle

Glob of varied thread pieces – to highlight the center of your flower

Decorative thread to sew down your petals and quilt your piece – shadow quilting will be demonstrated in class

1 piece transparent template material for cutting petal templates.
