

**CLASS TITLE: PAPER PIECING**

**DAY/TIME: WED afternoon**

***Marsha is teaching two different paper piecing classes,  
not related to each other.***

**FEE: \$1**

**SUPPLIES:**

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Your pattern (supplied)
- Your fabrics
- Thread to match the colors in your project. Gray works the best.
- Small scissors
- SEAM RIPPER
- Paper piecing paper (supplied)
- Plastic ruler large enough to cover largest section piece of your block plus 1 ½”.
- 3” x 5” piece of card stock (supplied)

**Please read all of the instructions before cutting fabric pieces.**

From each fabric you have chosen for your block, cut a piece to fit its corresponding placement in your block. Then place each piece in the chosen position of your pattern. If you're not happy with the look, you can make changes at this point without having sewn anything. (Paper pieced seams are difficult to rip out.)

Once you've chosen your fabrics (supplied), write the color selection you've made on the corresponding section of the pattern.

Place a plastic (see through) ruler over each section of your pattern, and cut out a piece of the fabric you have chosen for that section with a ¾” overlap on all sides. Do this for each section piece of the block. Once you have cut all your section pieces, stack the pieces by section and number the stacks to match the numbers on your pattern.
