Supply List

1 fat quarter plain black fabric (16" x 22")

1 fat quarter size piece of batting, black if you happen to have it

1 fat quarter for backing

1 fat quarter batik or other brightly colored fabric, batiks or hand dyes that have lots of colors work well

Binding

Black thread

White marking pencil

Small sharp pointed scissors

Seam ripper

Safety pins for layering

Sewing machine

Other supplies to consider bringing

Walking foot for your machine

Small ruler, compass depending on design chosen

I will have some quilting templates for you to use, including the butterfly the sample is made from. You can draw your own design, or find a design from any source. You can even draw your design on tear away stabiliser or paper, and sew through it. Keep in mind that you need at least 1/2" between sewing lines.

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This technique is similar to how molas are made and I will have samples of these . The fabric is marked, layered, the design sewed around, and then cut out. You can even use several different middle fabrics, which is how molas are constructed.
