Please come to class with material cut to size and be prepared to piece.

Finished size is approximately 20" x 20" composed of identical front and back.

MATERIAL LIST

To complete front and back, you'll need material for the following:

CENTER SECTION:

2 Center sections – 9"W x 20"L This section can be of quilting weight cotton or a heavier fabric such as drapery weight

SIDE STRIPS:***

4 strips #1 – 3"W x 20" L

4 strips #2 – 3"W x 20" L

4 strips to form side of satchel, each 2" W x 20" L

***As a shortcut, if fabric is non-directional, side strips can be cut from WOF. Leave in one piece, sew on, then trim at bottom and use the remaining as another strip

STRAP: material: 4 strips of fabric 2" W x 33" L. Interfacing if feels too thin doubled.

POCKET: Finished size is 9 ½ W x 8 ½ L so you'll need twice that amount

TOP BINDING: My preference 2 WOF cut 2 ¼" wide

STRAP CHANNEL: 2 strips of muslin 5 1/2" x 22 1/2" to form channel for strap.

4 1/2" **GROMMETS** (consisting of two parts for each) Home Depot's General Brand are the easiest to hammer in.. Kit, tools for class use, and grommets can be provided for \$3.00..

BATTING – at least 22x42, cut later, after piecing front & back and joining. I have used Warm & Natural

LINING: material approximately 22"x42"

Supplies

Sewing machine, thread and routine sewing supplies including rotary cutter.

Quilt Basting Spray or safety pins
