Sewing machine and all necessary notions. If you will be cutting in class bring your rotary cutter.

This quilt measures approx 46 x 54. There are 20 squares at 12 ½ inches. We need to make a minimum of 4 squares in order to slice and dice to get the desired scrappy look.

In order to make one square we need one 9 ½ square and one 6 ½ square.

Bring to class at least 4 of each (or 20 if you are making the full size).

Remember these are all scraps - the more diversity the better - you can even use the fabric that you bought and now don't even like.

The sashing is 3 ½ by 12 ½. The pattern calls for one color for the 2 sides and another color for the top and bottom. I put blue on the sides and red on the top and bottom. I didn't buy fabric I just used whatever I had in my stash. If it looked like red or if it looked like blue it worked for me. After we cut the sashing to 3 ½ by 12 ½ we will be cutting it again in class.

I did have to buy red fabric for the border.
