Wonky Star

To make a quilt top that is approximately 54" x 67.5" without borders: Four blocks wide by 5 blocks long, 20 blocks.

Materials

2 yards background fabric

2 yards of assorted fabrics at least 5" square or 130 Charm Squares (5")

If you just want to make a few blocks of the Wonky Star then for each block you will need five 5" squares of any fabric or fabrics of your choice for the star and eight 5" squares of one fabric for the background.

Sewing Materials

Sewing machine in good working order

Foot pedal for your machine

Power cord(s) for your machine

Extension cord for your machine

All the fabric you plan to use for your project

Thread to match your project (light gray works for almost all projects)

Seam ripper

Scissors

Plastic ruler at least 6 1/2" x 8 1/2"

Small Cutting mat/Rotary cutter

Straight pins
